Re: Enrichment Opportunities during Year 4

As your child prepares to move up to Year 4, we wanted to make you aware of the enrichment activities which are planned for your child during the new academic year.

“In2Music Tuition”

In the Autumn Term, your child will participate in brass lessons at school on a Friday afternoon. Berkshire Maestros run the lessons and a tutor will visit the school weekly to take the class for 45 minutes in a morning (the day is still to be confirmed). We have requested lessons for the entire academic year to maximise progress made with this activity. The school will be subsidising the cost of the music lessons but we are asking for £36 (payable in 3 termly installments, or one payment if you wish), for the lessons throughout the year. This will work out as £1 per lesson, which we hope you recognise as excellent value for money.

Under the terms of the Governors’ policy on charging, if the cost is not met by voluntary contributions from parents, this activity may have to be cancelled.

In September, you will also receive information about hiring instruments for the year for a nominal fee (around £30), but this information will come directly from Berkshire Maestros, as the contract will be with them.

Residential Trip

In the Summer Term, between 3rd - 5th June, Year 4 will be visiting Upton Court for a three-day residential visit. During this trip they will enjoy many outdoor adventure and team building activities. We will hold an information meeting in the Spring Term giving full details, but we wanted you to know the dates and cost involved now. The estimated cost of the trip next year will be **£145 per child** (NB. Children in receipt of Free School Meals and / or entitled to the Pupil Premium Grant will receive a discount). We will formally ask for a deposit of £50 in the Spring Term, with the balance payable in the Summer Term. However, we have set up this payment item on ParentPay now to allow you to pay gradually through the school year.

We are sure your child will benefit from the activities we have arranged and thank you for your continued support.
