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Dear Parents & Carers,

Year 6 Enrichment activities

As your child prepares to move up to Year 6, we wanted to make you aware of activities which are planned for your child during the new academic year, and the estimated costs to parents.

Bikeability

In **January 2019**, your child will have the opportunity to spend three days taking part in a Bikeability Course. This will give them valuable lessons in road awareness and cycling safely and with confidence. This is an 'optional extra' activity and estimated costs at this stage will be **£10 per child**. We will remind you of this activity and ask for payment nearer the time.

Rhos-y-gwaliau (RYG)

In the Spring Term, Year 6 will be visiting Rhos y Gwaliau for a week long residential visit on **3rd – 9th February 2019**. During this trip the children will enjoy many outdoor adventure and team building activities. There will be an information meeting for parents in the Autumn Term, but we wanted to give you an indication of the cost now.

Thanks to a grant from the Berkshire Outdoor Education Trust (BOET), the cost of the trip this year will be a subsidised **£295 per child** (NB. Children in receipt of Free School Meals and / or the Pupil Premium Grant will receive a further discount). This item will shortly be available on ParentPay, so you can make regular payments towards the total cost, to help with your budgeting. However, we will ask for a **£95 deposit to be paid by November**, with the balance payable in January.

Theatre Trip

In the summer term, the children will attend a theatre trip in London. The details of this are not confirmed at this stage but you can expect the cost to be around £30 (again payable in installments on ParentPay).

Other costs in Year 6

In addition, throughout the Year there will be fundraising events organised by the Year 6 children to cover the cost of their end of year trip. We would appreciate your help in supporting the children with these activities. There is also probably be an end of year family social event, but this will be wholly organised by the parents of the year group and the cost will depend on the activity chosen.

We know your child will greatly benefit from these activities, and hope they will participate.
