WHAT IS NEEDED IN SCHOOL?

- •A small bag (our lockers are small)
- Reading folder which goes home daily
- Coat and hat/gloves, wet weather clothes, sun hat
- Outdoor shoes
- •Lunch box, containing healthy snack and no plastic
- Water bottle
- •No pencil case or toys should be brought into school.

MORNING ROUTINES

- •The school doors open at 8:35am.
- •Children come in, place their small bag in their lockers and start a morning task. This time helps them to calm and focus on the day ahead and practice skills which will be applied in lessons.
- •The doors close at 8.50am and children will need to enter through the office after this time.

MORNING ROUTINES

- We try to keep children outside in all weathers. They will change into outdoor shoes and, if necessary, wet weather coat and trousers for break.
- Snacks should be healthy and without plastic wrappers. Fruit, cheese, vegetables are ideal in a reusable tub or bag.

INDEPENDENCE

- It is important that the children take more and more responsibility over their belongings.
- An evening checklist is a good way to ensure that they remember everything they need in school for themselves.
- It would be great if children were used to packing their own school / PE bags by the end of the year.

EXPECTATIONS AND REWARDS

Class Charter

Each class start the year by creating their Class Charter, which forms the class rules that each child agreed to follow.

House Points

House points will be awarded to children who follow the school values by showing polite manners, positive teamwork or excellent effort.

Celebration Assemblies

PE

HOME LEARNING

Each week your child should:


Read daily (in their heads and aloud);
